



A SAMPLE OF YOUR STAY IN MONTROUIS

General information:

- Lodging:** You will stay at the Hôtel Club Indigo, at some 2 kms from the village centre. Half-board (breakfast and dinner); single or double rooms.
- Transports:** Ground transportation in mini-vans, with taxi-motos, tap-taps...organized and supervised by our partner Association Abraham.
- Lunch :** Varies according to the activities from a sandwich picnic to a three dish meal, organized by Association Abraham.

- Jour 1:** Arrival and installation. Introduction to our local partners.
- Jour 2:** Visit to historical Montrouis and the Séradot market place.
Visit to a local orphanage or secondary school, recreational activity with children; meet with the young people of Association Abraham.
- Jour 3:** "Trail of the quiet streams" (a 5 hours hiking tour): banana plantations, green bean and watercress crops ; water ponds ; meet with local people and visit to the Haitian Mission primary school and health centre.
Evening: cultural workshop with Association Abraham.
- Jour 4:** Learn about food-crops and irrigation system in Montrouis ; visit to the « Place Impériale » and the Fishermen village; meet with fishermen families and local artists.
Introduction to the project « Creole Snack Bar » supported by the Fund.
Watch the coming of salt transport boats.
- Jour 5:** A full day excursion in mini-van to the northern part of the island.
Evening: free program.
- Jour 6:** Visit to St Marc.
Cultural workshop and evening with Association Abraham.
- Jour 7:** Free program.
Farewell party with Association Abraham.
- Jour 8:** Morning departure, overview of Port-au-Prince before returning to the airport.

Changes to the program may occur depending on weather conditions or any other relevant event, as well as following the participants' particular interests.

Minimum number of persons required for the program: 2.

Approximate price*: € 1000 /person (on the basis of a double room)

(*the program price will vary according to the USD – EURO rate, lodging options and program changes decided **before** the departure.)

25 % of the total price, except airfares and coordination fee, go to the Development Fund to support the local project "Creole Snack Bar". A steering committee (five members of the local community and one representative of EKIWAYS) is in charge of the management of the Fund and the follow-up of the project.
